- Understand the idea of classification and how animals can be grouped

Key Ideas

Art— Children will explore the idea that drawing as a 2 dimensional activity can be used to transform surfaces which can then be manipulated into a 3 dimensional object. Children explore how mark making, line, tonal value, colour, shape, and composition can be used to inform the final piece.

History—Children will learn where Egypt and the River Nile is and will be able to build a picture of the past 5000 years. They will focus on the iconic pyramids, the important religious beliefs and how to interpret evidence about Egyptian life.

PE— Y5 Swimming, Y5&6 Indoor Fitness and Outdoor Hockey.

RE—We will be exploring controversy around the relationship between the accounts in Genesis and contemporary scientific accounts.

Computing—Computing systems and networks – Systems and searching

Science— The concept of classification. Pupils will find out about how the method of sorting and grouping helped to recognise commonalities between living things. They will build their own keys using the characteristics of animals found in the local area.

PSHE—Children will learn about Health and wellbeing and how to look after themselves; growing up; becoming independent; taking more responsibility

Music— Children are given opportunities to compose and perform music inspired by their local community, past and present.
