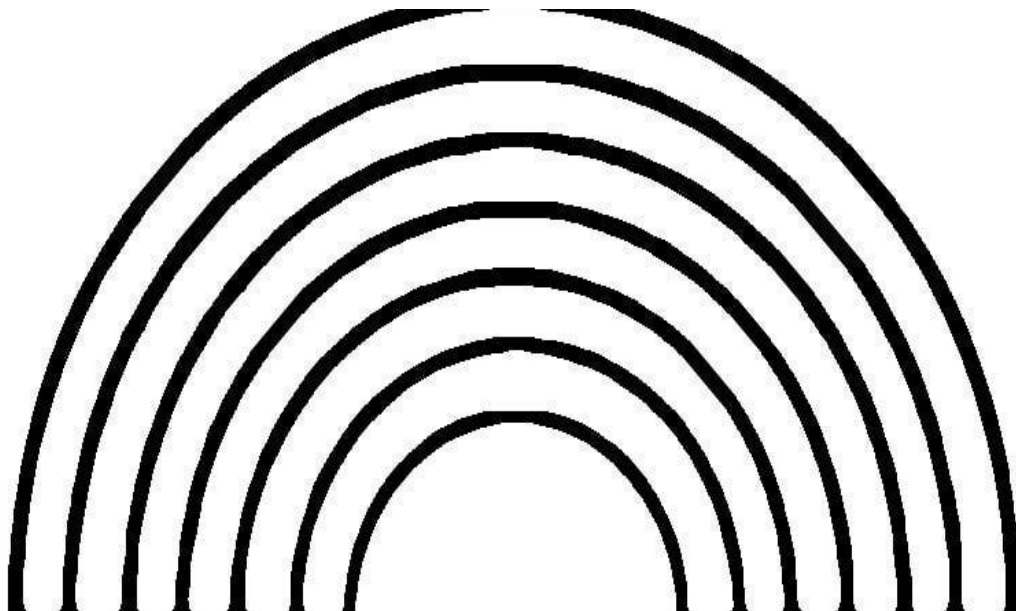


Year One and Two Homework Term 4— Fur, Feathers and Scales
