## Good Afternoon

We've had a very full week Hythe Bay the Y1/2 children had a fantastic day out at the Tower of London on Wednesday. The coach journey was long but it was well worth the trip – they learned about life in a castle and some of them were knighted! They explored the features of a castle like the portcullis for real rather than just looking at pictures and they saw the crown jewels including the crown worn by the King at the coronation. Did you know that the crown had to be enlarged, by adding more gold and two extra diamonds, to fit King Charles II? The children were beautifully behaved and a credit to Hythe Bay and their families.

This week we have been talking about resilience in worship and it's been great to hear how our children are learning to bounce back when life does not go quite as they would wish and how they can help one another to be more resilient.

There has been some fantastic learning on display. In Year R the children have been enjoying the Owl Babies story this week. In Key Stage Two, some children in Year Three and Four have been to the Glasshouse in Folkestone to do an Art Workshop which was great fun. Year Five and Six have also impressed me this week with their maths – they have been learning about factors, multiples, prime numbers and common factors. Even the teachers have been learning this week – on Tuesday evening Mr Gollop led a Maths Professional Development workshop showing teachers ways to make maths really practical and fun.

This week we have met with the new Speech and Language Therapist who has been designated to support Hythe Bay. The system within the NHS to access support from therapists has changed. But our school still school works to support children with speech, language and communication needs with support from our NHS link speech and language therapist, Karen Sheppard. Your child may come into contact with Karen within their classroom or around school. Claire Moffatt, SENCO will have regular meetings with Karen to discuss children who need support with their speech, language and communication. If you have any concerns about your child's speech, language or communication skills, please speak to your child's class teacher or Claire in the first instance. When we have discussed a specific concern with you about your child's speech, language or communication, or you have raised a concern, we will decide together whether to discuss this with our link therapist. You will of course be kept informed of any plans or interventions we have put in place to support your child.

Mrs Wiles has organised a Book Fair from  $11^{th}$  –  $18^{th}$  October. A wide range of books will be on sale in the entrance school after school. Come along and have a browse – a great chance to get a head of the Christmas Shopping.

Holiday Meal Vouchers for those who are eligible for benefit related Free School Meals will be sent out on Monday, if you have any issues with the system then chat to Sam in the office and she will be happy to try to help you.
