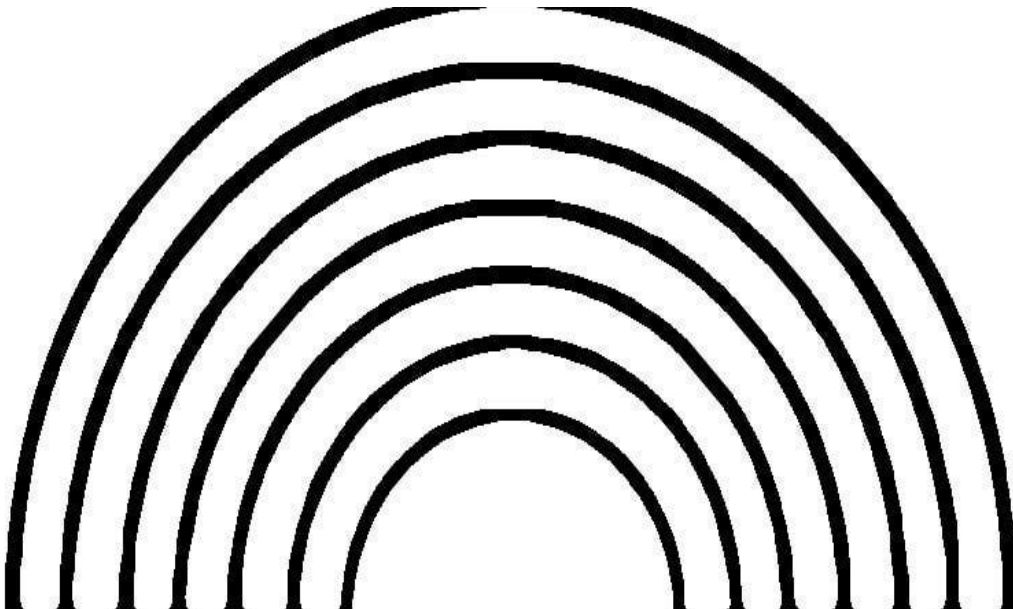


## Year One and Two Homework Term 3— Exploration
