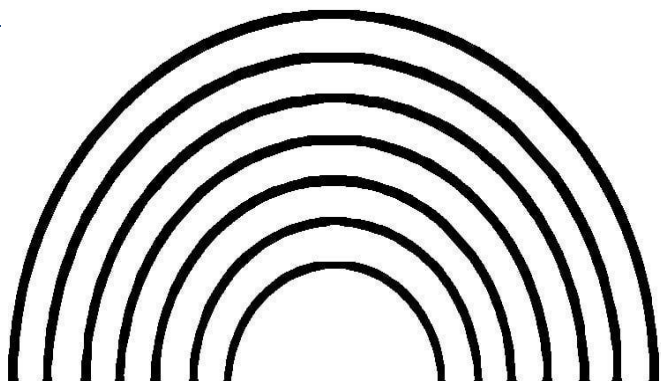


## Year 1 and 2 Homework Term 5 — How Does Your Garden Grow?
