Good Afternoon

This morning, our Harvest Festival took place at St Leonard's Church. We all walked up to the church in the sunshine and returned in the pouring rain! Possibly not being as thankful for the rain as we should have been at Harvest time. Every class performed a harvest song and Y4 lead our prayers. There was a terrific selection of Harvest Gifts which we will then donate to the Rainbow Centre in Folkestone.

Confirmed Covid-19 cases in school this week have settled down and several children have now returned to school. Many of you have been anxious if your children have been poorly and that is completely understandable. If you fear your child may have Covid-19 – go and get them a PCR test at the Stadium in Folkestone – if they are negative they can return to school immediately, if they are positive they will have to isolate for 10 days and Track and Trace will contact you and tell you what to do. Remember to let us know if your child is poorly and the results of any tests they have had – we still have to report cases daily to the Department of Education. However, remember many children have not been mixing in large groups for a while and the usual childhood germs – colds, sore throats and sickness bugs are rife at the moment because their natural immunity is low.

The Immunisation team will be in school on 5th November 2021 to give all children with consent the FLU vaccinations. The online consent portal is available online at <https://childconsent.co.uk/kchft/consent/search>
Don't forget to record your consent or refusal for your child's FLU vaccination before midnight on 2nd November 2021. Please use your child's NHS number or legal surname/date of birth/post code to access the form.


Please if you shop in Morrisons help us to collect vouchers for our gardening project, further details of how you can do this are attached to this newsletter.

If your child is in YR, 1 and 2 they are entitled to a universal free school meal every day. If you are in receipt of certain benefits you are entitled to benefit related free school meals. Some children in YR1 and 2 are entitled to benefit related free school meals but have not registered because their children get universal free school meals but if you are entitled to benefit related free school meals you should still register for them. The more children registered for benefit related free school meals we have, the more money we get in the school budget. So if you think you are entitled to benefit related free school meals chat with Sue or Sam in the office and they can help you register.
