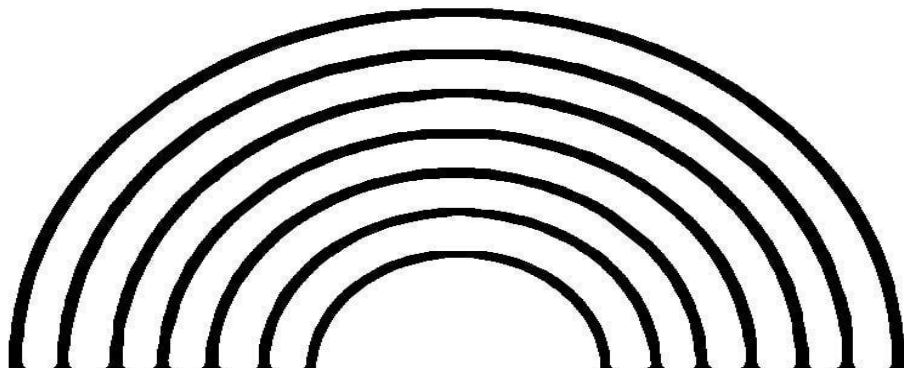


Year Three and Four Home Learning Grid Term 4 Were the Vikings really vicious?

Make a poster or video to teach someone how to do column addition or subtraction.	Where did the Vikings come from? Research this question and present your information in any way you wish.	Write a diary entry for a Viking warrior . Use the information you have learnt already.	Find out what Vikings ate and plan a Viking menu. Would you like to eat this meal? Why/ why not?	Make a 3D model of a Viking house.	Create a book review of a book you have recently read.
Make a game to practise the 4, 6, 7 or 8 times tables.	Why did the Vikings invade England? Find out and present in any way you like e.g. powerpoint, poster, paragraph, leaflet.	Write a story and include some speech. Remember to use inverted commas correctly.	Find out about Viking life. You could find out about food, clothing, farming, etc.	Make a Viking weapon or boat.	Do the Vikings deserve their reputation as Vicious? Explain your answer
How is Easter celebrated by Christians? Make a leaflet to present your information. Include the features of information texts eg. headings, sub-headings, bullet points, labelled diagrams.	Who was Ragnar Lodbrok? Research who he is and why he was important.	Create a video to teach year 1/2 something you have learnt at school this term.	Listen to a song you like. Which instruments can you hear? Why do you like it? Be ready to share it with us in class and tell us about it.	Design a Viking costume. You could draw it, or make one to go on a toy.	Evaluate your times table game. Ask for a sheet.
