Remember the meal is free to all children in Reception, Year one and two and to anyone eligible for a benefit related free school meal. For everyone else the cost is £2.41. Children may also bring packed lunches to eat that day.

From January 1st the price of a school dinner will rise to £2.45.

Just a quick reminder that parents cannot park on the school site during drop off and pick up time unless they have Blue Badge or a sticker from the school giving them permission to access the school car park. We need to keep traffic on the site to a minimum to ensure the safety of all our children.
