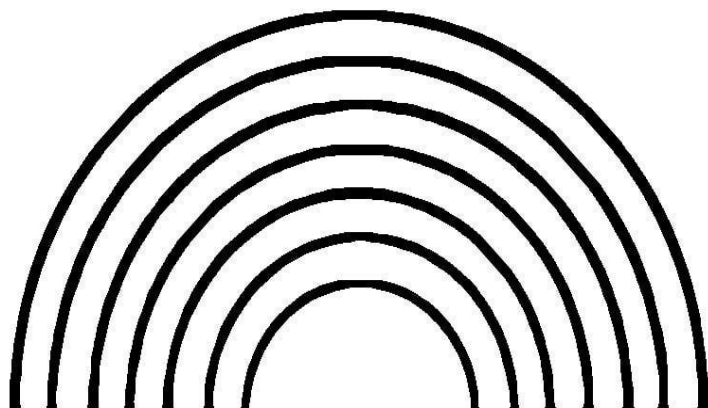

Where will its new home be?</p>	<p>Create a dinosaur scene using only 2D shapes. Which parts of the scene were the most tricky to represent? Why?</p>
