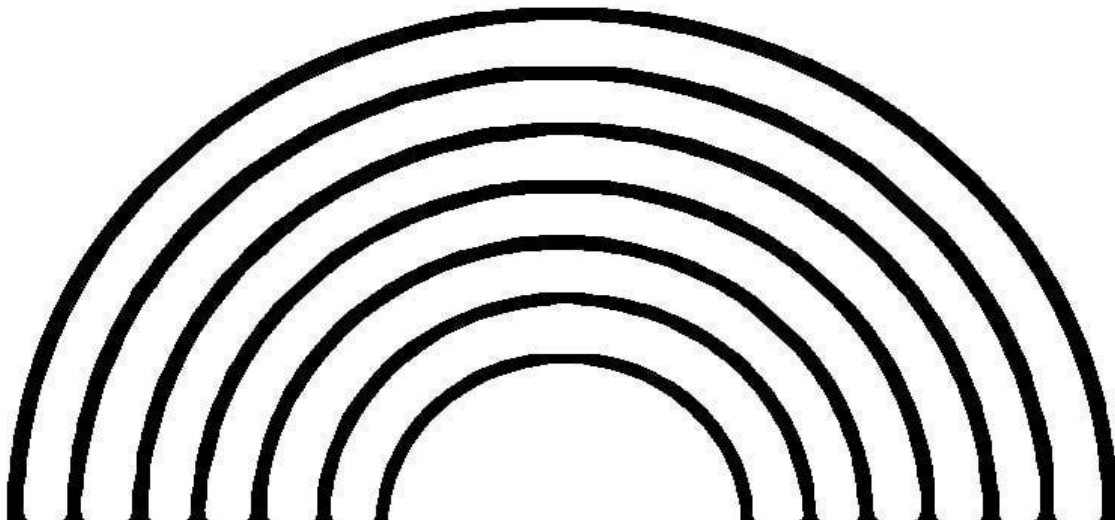


Year One And Two Homework Term 6 – Why does the light shine?
