To be able to describe the difference between the Sahara desert and Antarctica.

Why does Easter matter to Christians?

To be able rapidly recall 2, 5 and 10 times table.

That penguins do not just live in Antarctica.

Key Ideas

Geography—Antarctica vs Sahara Desert: To compare both places and look at how penguins have adapted to Antarctica. To compare geographical features and the differences between the North and the South Pole.

Religious Education- Easter story: To explore the Easter story and make links between the Big Story and Easter. To be able to explain why Easter matters to Christians.

PSHE— Money: Where does money come from and how is it used? To explore what money is, what to do with it and how to keep it safe.

Art—To be able to enjoy others art: Looking closely at insects and plants. To draw using pens, oil pastels and graphite and sharing their work with an audience.

English— Recount writing: To be able to write a detailed recount of an event. Being able to cover who, what, where and when and include their personal point of view.

Maths —Addition and subtraction: To be able to rapidly record number bonds to 10 and 20. To be able to use their knowledge of doubles in addition and subtraction sentences.

Multiplication: recalling times table knowledge of 2, 5 and 10 times tables and applying to mathematical problems.
