From now on the term gets incredibly busy, so much to fit in and not enough days until the end of term to do it all. This has been another busy week, on Thursday we had a World Faith Storytelling Day, classes gathered together in tents, the learning zone and on the field around the school and told and heard stories from different world faiths. It brought joy to my heart to see children snuggled up enjoying stories with their teachers.

We played football on Wednesday against Saltwood School. The first match was for the Girls Football team and despite a sterling effort by all we lost 3-1. We then played a Y3/4 Boys match – as a spectator my anxiety levels were through the roof, as the most spectacular football skills were displayed by both teams – but in the end we won 3-4.

Y1/2 are having a cake sale on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July after school in aid of the RNLI, the "Lifeboat People" will be in school next week telling the children in Y1/2 all about the very important work they do.

Remember it is really important that children in YR/1 and 2 read their Little Wandle books every week online. Children read their books in school on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and have a phonics lesson every day. Teachers then allocate the books carefully tailored to match the teaching that has taken place in class to children so they can practise their reading at home. All the educational research tells us that children who practise reading at home achieve higher reading levels. You will have received log in details for this online reading system. If you are unsure how to access these books or have mislaid the login details, talk to your child's class teacher and she will be able to help you.

Many of you have been asking about Sports Day which will be held on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July - this year KS2 will be in the morning (9.30am) and KS1 in the afternoon (1.30pm) if you would like to make a day of it you can bring a picnic lunch to enjoy that with your children on the field or join the children for a school lunch in the hall. Adult School Lunches would need to be **booked and paid for in advance by 11<sup>th</sup> July** at the office and will cost £2.95.

As the weather is warming up, just a reminder that children need sun cream, hats and plenty of water in school to keep them fully hydrated please.
