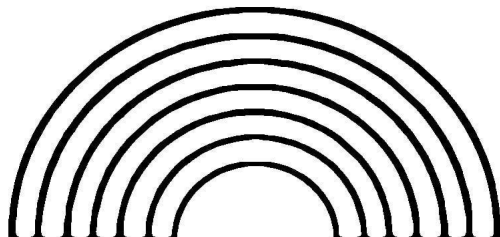


HARBOUR SEALS CLASS SRP Homework Term 3—FANTASTIC MR FOX

What would you differently next time?</p>	<p>Fantastic Mr Fox was written by Roald Dahl. Can you find out about some other books that he wrote? Have you read any of them?</p> <p>Compare them to the story of Mr Fox. Think about the characters, places and events.</p> <p>What is the SAME?</p> <p>What is DIFFERENT?</p> <p>Which one is your favourite?</p>	<p>Design and make a new home for Mr and Mrs Fox that will keep them safe from the farmers. Use any materials you like as long as you can name them!</p> <p>CHALLENGE: Can you invent a device to warn them if the farmers are coming?</p>	<p>Write a letter to our visitor thanking them for coming in to talk to us about foxes. Tell them what you most enjoyed about their visit and something that you learned about their work.</p>

Are there different types of foxes? How do they differ from other animals?
